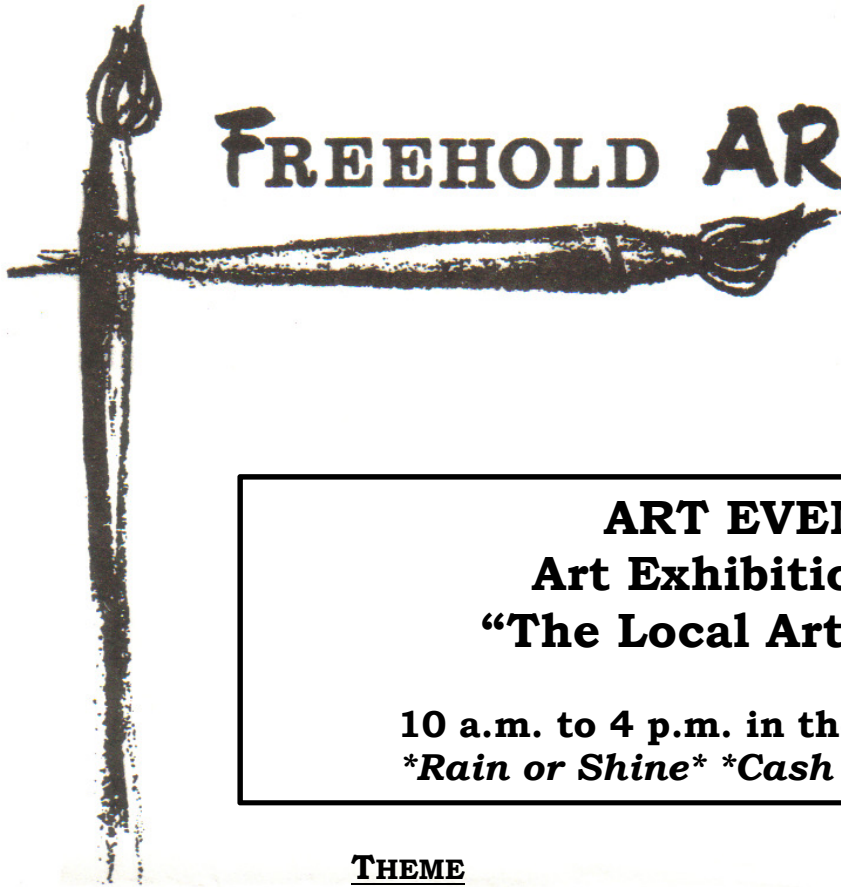

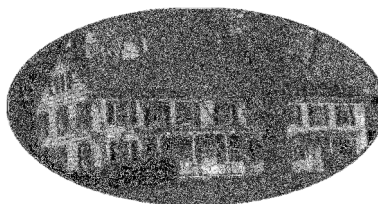

HOW TO PARTICIPATE:

Freehold Art Society Members are invited to bring their painting/drawing gear to the grounds of the Oakley Farmstead and paint the barns, houses, outbuildings, gardens, etc.

Check in begins at 8:30 a.m. at the barn where the "Local Artist Scene" Art Exhibition 2017 takes place. There is no charge for this plein-air event. Artists may sell their plein-air piece, as well as any work in the Art Exhibition 2017 (see reverse).

Restrooms are conveniently located in the main farmhouse. Parking is on the street. Restaurants abound in the immediate vicinity. Other on-site activities include tours of the 300 year old farmhouse and a bake sale. In conjunction with *Weekend in Old Monmouth*, historic sites nearby will also be open, free of charge, including: West Freehold School on Wemrock Road; Jewish Heritage Museum of Monmouth County off Wemrock Road; Covenhoven House on West Main Street in Freehold Borough; the Monmouth County Historical Association Museum on Court Street in Freehold Borough; and Monmouth Battlefield State Park on Route 33 in Manalapan.
